Dear Ms. Mills-Williams:

This letter serves to advise you that your employment with the Government of the Virgin Islands as Special Assistant Attorney General to the Attorney General of the Virgin Islands is hereby terminated effective Friday, November 13, 2015 at 5:00 PM.

I am taking this action because I am deeply concerned that you have chosen to align yourself with an attorney whom you should know is a convicted criminal and an individual who is known for consorting with persons who have been convicted on more than one occasion of trafficking in, distributing and using narcotics and other illegal substances in and through the US Virgin Islands. As Special Assistant Attorney General to the Attorney General of the Virgin Islands, I am not confident that your access and potential influence to ongoing criminal investigations and evidence would not be compromised on behalf of and through your association with Attorney Lee J. Rohn.

Accordingly and through this communique, I am directing the Attorney General to immediately terminate your access to any property, file, server, telephonic system and property owned, operated or managed by the Department of Justice, In addition, I am further directing the Attorney General to process a payroll payment for you for the period of Monday, October 5, 2015 through the last day you were physically present at work at the Department of Justice.

I would like to thank you for your service to the people of the Virgin Islands and wish you well in all your future endeavours.
