## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

- 2 **SECTION 1.** Act No. 7535 is amended in section 2 in the following instances:

- 5 (b) Line Item "M1116 DOP-Buck Consultants" is amended by striking
- 6 "\$288,000" and inserting "\$320,000";
- 7 (c) Line item "New DPNR-Tutu Well Litigation Site" is amended by striking
- 8 "405,000" and inserting "\$450,000";
- 9 (d) Line item "New GERS-Outstanding Contributions to Government
- Employees who retired after December 31, 2012" is amended by striking "\$1,500,000"
- 11 and inserting "\$2,500,000".

6	SECTION 2. Act No. 7557 is amended in Section I by striking "\$19,000,000"				
7	and inserting "\$18,800,000".				
8	SECTION 3. Act No. 7558 is amended in Section 1 (a) by striking				
9	"\$28,023,865" and inserting "\$27,723,865".				
10	SECTION 4. The following sums for the purposes set forth in paragraphs (1)				
11	through (3) are appropriated from the General Fund for the fiscal year ending September				
12	30, 2014:				
13	(1) Juan Luis Hospital-Upgrade Electronic Medical Records \$1,000,000-				
14	Payroll July-September 2014 \$11,000,000- Total \$12,000,000				
15	(2) Roy Lester Schneider Hospital-Accounts Payable \$7,000,000, Capital

17	(3) Department of Human Services for assistance to Sea View Nursing Home				
18	for outstanding debt \$1,500.000

21	SECTION 5. Act No. 7499 is amended at the end of Section 7 (c) by adding				
22	paragraphs (1) through (3):				

1	(1) "The Government of the Virgin Islands is authorized to re-issue a working		
2	capital loan in the amount \$50,000,000 prior to the end of FY 2014. The notes must		
3	mature no later than 270 days after issuance with the following conditions:		
4	(2) A Task force consisting of nine persons shall investigate and report to the		
5	Legislature by December 12, 2014 the following:		
6	(A) the consolidation cost reduction and increased efficiency of a		
7	centralized GVI information technology system, operation protocol and vehicle		
8	fleet		
9	(B) Changes to tax collection, administrative practices and strategies at		
10	the Bureau of Internal Revenue, giving particular attention to increased tax		
11	compliance, discovery auditing and supply chain;		
12	(C) Cost reduction and efficiencies in the VI Government specific		
13	procurement, asset use and supply chain; and		
14	(D) Specific energy conservation and energy cost reduction initiatives		
15	that reduce energy consumption by at least 20% at the Departments of Health,		
16	Public Safety, Finance, Education the Juan Luis Hospital, the Schneider Hospital		
17	the Waste Management Authority and for public facility and street lighting;		
18	(3) The task force is comprised of three appointees by the Governor, three		
19	appointees by the President of the Legislature and three appointees by the Presiding		
20	Judge of the Superior Court. The Task Force shall provide a three year projection of GVI		
21	revenues, three year projection of operating expenses by agency based on 2014 projected		
22	spending ranked by the head of each agency identifying		
23	(A) the essential service in each operating unit,		

1	(B) the net operating cost and a three year projection of operating expenses by
2	agency based on a 5% reduction from 2014 projected spending."
3	SECTION 6. Act No. 7560 (Bill No. 30-0250), section 7, subsection (a),
4	paragraph (1) is stricken.
