2	SECTION 1. Title 1 is amended by adding a new section 200c to read as follows;	
3	§"200c (a) this section may be cited as "The Disability History Month Act".	
4	(b) The month of October is designated "Disability History Month". Annually during the	
5	month of October, each public school shall conduct and promote educational activities that provide	
6	instruction, awareness and understanding of disability history and people with disabilities. The activities	
7	must include various events, such, as school assemblies and guest-speaker presentations."
