## **PARDON**

OF

## **ALICIA "CHUCKY" HANSEN**

WHEREAS, Alicia "Chucky" Hansen was born on December 6, 1952 in Puerto Rico.

WHEREAS, Alicia "Chucky" Hansen attended the Jose C. Barbosa High School and the Inter-American University, both of Puerto Rico and the University of the Virgin Islands.

WHEREAS, Alicia "Chucky" Hansen is married to Esdel Hansen and together they have four (4) children.

**WHEREAS**, Alicia "Chucky" Hansen has been a Senator of the United States Virgin Islands, serving ten (10) terms with her most recent in the 30<sup>th</sup> Legislature.

WHEREAS, Alicia "Chucky" Hansen was found guilty by a jury of her peers of three (3) counts of wilful failure to file income tax returns in violation of V.I. CODE ANN tit. 33 §1524.

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2009, Alicia "Chucky" Hansen was sentenced to a one (1) year term of suspended incarceration and one (1) year of probation for each of her three (3) convictions, to be served consecutively.

WHEREAS, by Order of the District Court of the Virgin Islands dated June 22, 2012, Alicia "Chucky" Hansen completed her period of supervised release on May 27, 2012, and was discharged from probation.

WHEREAS, Alicia "Chucky" Hansen had no prior criminal record or conviction before she was charged with the crimes referenced herein.

WHEREAS, Alicia "Chucky" Hansen has requested the opportunity to continue to serve the people of the Virgin Islands as their elected Senator and continue to be a productive member of society. **NOW, THEREFORE**, by the powers vested in me by Section 11 of the Revised Organic Act of 1954, as amended, and for the aforementioned reasons, I, John P. de Jongh, Jr, Governor, of the United States Virgin Islands, do hereby pardon the convictions of Alicia "Chucky" Hansen for the crimes of wilful failure to file income tax returns under V.I. CODE ANN. tit. 33, §1524 and restore her civil rights in all respects.
