An Act amending the Virgin Islands Code, title 5, chapter 401, section 4509 (d) and title 31, chapter 1, section 1 relating to the use of inmate labor from the Bureau of Corrections for roadwork and maintenance of government buildings and for other purposes

PROPOSED BY: Senator Myron D. Jackson

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:

2 SECTION 1. Title 5 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 401, section 4509 (d) is amended
3 after "maintenance" by inserting "and repairs".

4 **SECTION 2.** Title 31 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 1, section 1 is amended by 5 designating the existing provisions as subsection (a) and adding subsection (b) to read as 6 follows:

7 "(b) To the extent practicable, the Commissioner of Public Works shall use a prison 8 inmate workforce for all roadwork, cemetery maintenance, waterways, drainage, and 9 maintenance & repairs of government buildings." The prison inmate workforce used by the 10 Commissioner of Public Works under this subsection must consist of only misdemeanor and 11 non-violent felon inmates and inmates whose remaining prison term does not exceed six 12 months in duration."

1	BILL SUMMARY
2 3	This Bill in section 1 amends Virgin Islands Code, title 5, chapter 401, section 4509
4	(d) by adding repairs of government buildings to the list of projects for which the Department
5	of Public Works is required to seek labor from inmates at the Bureau of Corrections. Section
6	2 amends 31 V.I.C. §1 relating to the functions of the Commissioner of the Department of
7	Public Works, which requires the Commissioner to repair and maintain, among other
8	government properties, government buildings. To the extent practicable, this section would
9	require the Department to use non-violent prison inmates for all road projects waterways and
10	drainage maintenance and repairs of government buildings.
