An Act providing for the erection of a full length statue of Virgin Islands hero, world boxing champion, the late Emile Griffith in his boxing gloves and fighter's stance at the Emile Griffith Ballpark on St. Thomas and for other purposes

PROPOSED BY: Senators Myron D. Jackson and Tregenza A. Roach

- Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:
- 2 SECTION 1. Pursuant to the authority conferred by title 3 Virgin Islands Code, chapter
- 3 18, sections 301 et. Seq., the Commissioner of the Department of Sports, Parks and Recreation in
- 4 conjunction with the Virgin Islands Council on the Arts shall erect a full-length statue of Virgin
- 5 Islands hero, world boxing champion, the late Emile Griffith, showcased in his boxing gloves
- 6 and fighter's stance at the Emile Griffith ballpark on the island of St. Thomas. The statue must
- 7 be accompanied by a plaque with historical details of Emile Griffith's life.
- 8 SECTION 2. The Department of Planning and Natural Resources shall designate and
- 9 appropriately mark, with the consent of the family of the late Emile Griffith's childhood home at
- 10 No. 6 Princesse Gade, Crown Prince Quarter as a historical site of memory to be placed in the
 - 11 Virgin Islands Registry of Historic Places.

SECTION 3. (a) The sum of \$30,000 is appropriated for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2015, from the General Fund to the Virgin Islands Council on the Arts to commission a statute of world boxing champion, Emile Griffith, to be erected at the Emile Griffith ball park by the Department of Sports, Parks and Recreation.

(b) The sum appropriated in subsection (a) remains available until expended."

SECTION 4. Title 33 Virgin Islands code, chapter 111 is amended by adding an appropriately numbered section to read as follows:

"§ The Emile Griffith Memorial Fund

There is hereby created and established in the Treasury of the Virgin Islands a special fund to be known as the Emile Griffith Memorial Fund. The Commissioner of Finance shall maintain and provide for the administration of said Fund as a separate and distinct fund in the treasury and no monies shall be available for expenditure except upon authorization the Department of Planning and Natural Resources in conjunction with the Virgin Islands Council on the Arts. The Fund shall consist of donations of any kind and appropriations made by the Legislature. Monies from the fund shall be used exclusively for the maintenance of the Emile Griffith Ball Park and such projects that the Virgin Islands Council on the Arts considers pertinent to the recognition and remembrance of the legacy of Emile Griffith."

BILL SUMMARY

Section 1 of this Bill directs the Commissioner of the Department of Sports, Parks and Recreation to creet a statue of Emile Griffith showcase in his boxing gloves and fighter's stance at the Emile Griffith Ballpark and the statute must be accompanied by a plaque with historical details of his life.

Section 2 of the Bill requires the Department of Planning and Natural Resources to mark and designate No. 6 Princesse Gade, Emile Griffith's childhood home, as a historical site of memory to be placed in the Virgin Islands Registry of Historic Places.
