PROPOSED BY: Senator Kenneth L. Gittens
Be it enacted by the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:
SECTION 1. Title 14, Virgin Islands Code, section 2253, subsection (f) is amended in
the following instances:
(1) by striking "hundred" wherever it appears and inserting "thousand" in lieu
thereof;
(2) after the first appearance of "private youth center" by inserting ", school bus
stop"; and
(3) by striking "or private youth center" the second time it appears and inserting
"public or private senior citizen center" in place thereof.
BILL SUMMARY
This bill expands the area within which it is a violation to carry firearms from one
hundred feet to one thousand feet and also includes senior citizen centers and school bus stops.
