Thirty-Second Legislature of the Virgin Islands

An Act amending the Virgin Islands Code, titles 3, 5, 14, 15, 16, 19, 23, 27, and 34 to change all references to mental health to behavioral health; amending title 19, chapter 31, section 716 (a) relating to the Citizens Council on Mental Illness Alcoholism and Drug Dependency; repealing section 14 of Act No. 7897 and section 2, paragraph (1) of Act No. 7697; appropriating \$3,000,000 for the establishment of a behavioral health care facility on the island of St. Croix; and establishing requirements for the operation of in-patient and out-patient treatment programs at the behavioral health care facility

1 WHEREAS, there is a critical need for an inpatient psychiatric unit on the island of

- 2 St. Croix; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the inpatient psychiatric unit of the Juan F. Luis Hospital closed in
- 4 2012; and
- 5 WHEREAS, there are approximately 700 persons registered within the Virgin
- 6 Islands Department of Health to receive behavioral health outpatient services- 300 on St.
- 7 Thomas, 300 in Christiansted, 90 in Frederiksted and 26 on St. John; and

1	WHEREA	S, the short -term intake solutions provided by the Juan F. Luis Hospital
2	and the Roy L. S	Schneider Regional Medical Facility are inadequate for persons needing
3	acute care; and	
4	WHEREA	S, the lack of a local facility to house persons with behavioral health
5	issues requiring	long-term care requires the territory to spend several millions every year
6	to house these pa	atients in facilities in California, Georgia, Puerto Rico and Texas; and
7	WHEREA	AS, on September 23, 2016, Governor Kenneth E. Mapp declared a state
8	of emergency in	mental health care; and
9	WHEREA	AS, the Legislature finds and declares that the establishment of a behavioral
10	health care facili	ty will benefit residents in need of behavioral health care; Now, Therefore,
11	Be it enacted by	the Legislature of the Virgin Islands:
12	SECTION	11. (a) The following sections of the Virgin Islands Code are amended by
13	striking every oc	currence of the term, "mental health", and inserting "behavioral health":

1	(b) Title 19 Virgin Islands Code, chapter 31, section 716, (c) is amended in the
2	following instances:
3	(a) by striking "Citizens Advisory Council on Mental Illness
4	Alcoholism and Drug Dependency" and inserting "Virgin Islands Behavioral
5	Health, Alcoholism and Drug Dependency Planning Council and Advisory Board";
6	and
7	(b) by adding the following at the end of the first sentence after
8	"guidelines": "including a youth representative, family members of consumers,
9	members of provider agencies, and representatives from the Department of Health,
10	the Department of Human Services and a Federally Qualified Health Facility".
11	SECTION 2. Act No. 7897, section 14 is repealed.
12	SECTION 3. Act No. 7697, section 2 is amended by striking paragraph (1) in its
13	entirety.
14	SECTION 4. The following sums are appropriated from the General Fund to the
15	Department of Health in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, for a behavioral health
16	care facility on the island of St. Croix.
17	(a) From the savings realized in section 2 of this act, the sum of \$2,000,000 is
18	appropriate for development of real property at Plot No. 184 in Estate Anna's Hope, St.
19	Croix, Virgin Islands, including the design and construction of an inpatient psychiatric
20	services facility; and
21	(b) From the saving realized in section 3 of this act, the sum of \$1,000,000 is
22	appropriated for the development of Outpatient intensive treatment program.
23	SECTION 5. The Department of health shall establish behavioral health facility that
24	must:
25	(1) contain a minimum of 25 inpatient beds;

1	(2) provide outpatient services, including specialized outpatient services for		
2	children, the elderly, individuals who are have chronic behavioral health issues, and		
3	residents of its behavioral health service area who have been discharged from inpatient		
4	treatment;		
5	(3) provide 24-hour-a-day emergency care services;		
6	(4) provide day treatment or other partial hospitalization services, or		
7	psychosocial rehabilitation services; and		
8	(5) comply with all local and federal licensing and accreditation standards to meet		
9	individual patient needs for children, adolescents and adults; and		
10	(6) address the critical needs and recommendations identified in the Five-Year		
11	Mental Health Plan.		
12	SECTION 6. The sum authorized and appropriated in section 4 remain available		
13	until expended.		
14	BILL SUMMARY		
15	Section 1 amends the Virgin Islands Code to change all references to "mental health"		
16	to behavioral health.		
17	Section 2 repeals section 14 of Act 7897, which appropriated 2,000,000 from the St.		
18	Croix Capital Improvement Fund to the Virgin Islands Housing Finance Authority to		
19	access Federal New Market Tax Credit funding for the purpose of financing the		
20	construction of a new Herbert Grigg Home for the Aged.		
21	Section 3 of the bill repeals section 2 paragraph (1) of Act No. 7697 which		
22	appropriated \$1,000,000.00 o the Governor Juan F. Luis Hospital and Medical Facility to		
23	rebuild and restore the acute care inpatient psychiatric unit.		
24	Section 4 appropriated \$3,000,000 to the Department of Health for a behavioral		
25	health care facility.		
26	Section 5 imposes requirements for the operation of the behavioral health care		
27	facility.		
28	Section 6 provides for non- lapsing appropriations in the bill.
